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INTRODUCTION

Cheshire Jets are one of the biggest basketball clubs in the UK and run the following programmes:

- A highly successful team in the British Basketball League, winning 7 trophies since 2001 and challenging for honours in 2010/11.

For 7-10 year olds with some basketball experience at school or club level. *Non residential.*

Regular Camp, Big Man Camp and Junior Plus Camp are from Sunday 24th July at 14:00 and then daily (09:00-21:00) until Friday 29th July (finishing at 14:00).

JUNIOR CAMP

For 7-10 year olds who are beginners with little or no basketball experience. *Non residential. Junior camp runs from Monday 25th July (daily from 09:00-16:00) until Friday 29th July (finishing at 14:00).*
